According to rules of this show, professional is considered an artist who engages in artwork for gain (having taught and/or sold artwork), having much experience and skill.

Non-Professional Professional Young Artists (under the age of 16)

All paintings must be framed or matted and ready to hang unless it is a non-traditional medium. If so, contact the library for more information. Due to space constraints, overly large pieces may be denied entry.

Each entry must be labeled on the back with the attached form giving the **ARTIST'S NAME**, **CATEGORY**, **ADDRESS** and **PHONE NUMBER**. All entries for sale should indicate price. <u>A 10% commission will be charged for each sale</u>.

The Festival and the Iberville Parish Library are not responsible for theft or damage of any artwork, although the show will be closely supervised and every reasonable precaution will be taken to insure its safety.

Ribbons and awards for First, Second and Third place and Best in Show will be awarded in each category. The awards are made possible through a donation by **IBERVILLE PARKS AND RECREATION** and **FRIENDS OF THE IBERVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARIES**. Judge's decisions are final.
